Crochet Baby Hat Pattern for Covenant HealthCare

CROCHET BABY HAT

Use F size crochet hook. Finished hat should measure 10" wide by $6 - 6\frac{1}{2}$ " long. Chain 14 – slip stitch to form a circle, being careful not to twist chain. Chain 1 (Chain 1 counts as a SC in next 4 rows)

- 1st Round Single Crochet (SC) in each chain to the end of round chain 1 (15 SC)
- 2nd Round SC in next 2 stitches , 2 SC in next stitch to the end of the round (Join with slip stitch to 1st CH 1) chain 1 (20 SC)
- 3rd Round SC in next 3 stitches 2 SC in next stitch to the end of the round (Join with slip stitch to 1st CH 1) chain 1 (25 SC)
- 4th Round Repeat row three chain 2 (counts as half double crochet (HDC) in next round) (31 SC)
- 5th Round HDC in next 3 stitches 2 HDC in next stitch to end of round 0 (join with a slip stitch to top of CH 2) Chain 2 (counts as double crochet (DC) in next round (38 HDC)
- 6th round DC in each stitch, (join with slip stitch at top of CH 2) (38 DC)
- 7th round DC in next 3 stitches 2 DC in next stitch to end of round (join with slip stitch at top of CH 2) (47 DC)
- 8th round dc in each stitch, (join with slip stitch at top of ch 2) Hat should now measure 10" (5 when folded) wide. If not, increase stitches to make that measurement.
- Repeat 8th round until hat measures $6 6\frac{1}{2}$ " high. Gather the hole at top and attach a pom-pom.
